All applications are considered by the Centre's Fellowships and Visitors Committee whose decisions are ratified by the Academic Council. Required documentation:

1. Completed Application Form
2. Curriculum Vitae
3. List of Publications
4. References from two academic referees
5. A statement of the research you intend to work on during your tenure at the Centre, including the use that would be made of Oxford libraries and the Centre's own Library and Archives.
