

CALL FOR PAPERS FOR POSTGRADUATE WORKSHOP
70 Years of the Dead Sea Scrolls

The Centre for the Study of the Bible in the Humanities, the Centre for Hebrew and Jewish Studies, and the Hebrew Bible Seminar and New Testament Seminar in the Faculty of Theology and Religion, have each devoted a term over the course of this academic year to scholarship on the Dead Sea Scrolls seventy years since they were first discovered.

A postgraduate workshop will be held on Friday 21 June 2019 as a culmination of this year of celebration, with keynote lectures by Professor George Brooke (Manchester) and Professor Eibert Tigchelaar (Leuven).

Graduate students and early career scholars interested in presenting a short (20-minute) paper on any topic related to the Dead Sea Scrolls should send a paper title and brief abstract to Sue Forteath (sue.forteath@ochjs.ac.uk) by 8 February 2019. Successful applicants will be informed by 22 February, when the full schedule of the workshop will be announced.
