

## INFORMATION FOR JUNIOR VISITING SCHOLAR APPLICANTS

## **Application Procedure**

The Oxford Centre invites applications for Junior Visiting Scholar status at any time throughout the year. The period of tenure for a Junior Visiting Scholar is normally between two and six months during term time (summer visits are not possible) and must include at least one University of Oxford term. Exceptionally, other periods may be considered.

All applications are considered by the Oxford Centre's Fellowships and Visitors Committee, whose decisions are ratified by the Hebrew and Jewish Studies Management Committee.

Please note that the Committee will only consider complete applications (see "Required Documentation" below). The responsibility for ensuring that references are received on time rests solely with the applicant.

## **Required Documentation:**

- 1. Completed Junior Visiting Scholar Application Form
- 2. Curriculum Vitae
- 3. List of Publications
- 4. References from two academic referees
- 5. A two-/three-page statement detailing the research you intend to conduct during your tenure at the Oxford Centre (including the use that you would make of Oxford libraries and the Centre's own Library and Archives)
