Job Y. Jindo teaches Semitic languages, biblical studies, and comparative religion at the Academy for Jewish Religion in the United States. His research interests span from phenomenology of biblical religion, to comparative religion (esp., eastern religions), modern Jewish biblical interpretation, mindfulness in the East and the West, memory of the dead and the identity of the living, and cross-cultural and cross-religious dialogue. His publications include *Biblical Metaphor Reconsidered* (Harvard Semitic Monograph Series, 2010) and, with Benjamin Sommer and Thomas Staubli, *Yehezkel Kaufmann and the Reinvention of Jewish Biblical Scholarship* (Orbis Biblicus et Orientalis, 2017).
