(Yeshiva University)

'Hardening of Hearts in Late Medieval Jewish Philosophical Exegesis'

Dr Shira Weiss is the Assistant Director of the Sacks-Herenstein Center for Values and Leadership of Yeshiva University and teaches Jewish Thought in The Bernard Revel Graduate School of Jewish Studies. She holds a PhD in Medieval Jewish Philosophy and has been awarded fellowships from the National Endowment of Humanities, The Templeton Foundation and Ben Gurion University. Dr Weiss is the author of *Joseph Albo on Free Choice* (Oxford University Press, 2017), *Ethical Ambiguity in the Hebrew Bible* (Cambridge University Press, 2018), co-author of *The Protests of Job: An Interfaith Dialogue* (Palgrave MacMillan, 2022), as well as articles in academic journals and anthologies.
