'Identity and Alterity in Pre-War Judeo-Spanish Literature (Salonika, 1900-1940)'

Sarah Gimenez is a doctor of linguistics and language didactics at INALCO (Paris). She defended her thesis in 2021 and was awarded the prize for best thesis in Jewish Studies by the Société des Etudes Juives and the Mémorial de la Shoah. Her thesis was a critical edition of I. S. Révah's manuscript of proverbs (Judeo-Spanish, Salonika, 1936). She also works for the LJTrad project, which aims to establish an anthology of Judeo-Spanish literature, and for the ALIENTO project, which aims to establish correspondences between different sapiential corpora circulating in the Iberian Peninsula in the Middle Ages.
