Determining Belonging: The State of Israel and the Question of Emerging Jewish Communities

Ms Alicia Vergara Murillo is a third-year DPhil student in Asian and Middle Eastern Studies at the University of Oxford. She holds a BA in Social Sciences from the Humboldt University of Berlin and an MSt in Jewish Studies.
